Pools, Hot Tub, Fitness Room, Steam Room, Sauna and Meeting Room hours are 7 AM-10 PM each day.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Refrain from any behavior that might disturb the enjoyment of other guests.
- 2. Do not hang any items (including towels) on the balcony railings or on any part of the building or parts thereof.
- 3. Animals are not allowed anywhere on property other than Service Animal defined by Title II and Title III of the ADA.
- 4. Fireworks are not allowed anywhere on property, boardwalk, or the beach.
- 5. Scooters, bikes, skateboards, or rollerblades are not allowed in buildings, tennis courts, pools, or hot tub areas.
- 6. There is a 10-mph speed limit, unless otherwise posted, while driving on property.
- 7. No personal grills are allowed on property.
- 8. Do not feed or approach any wildlife on the premises.
- 9. No items (including personal) can be stored at any time in any common area of the building such as stairwells, hallways, lobbies, pools or restrooms nor the beach an hour after sunset. They will be confiscated & not returned.
- 10. The Association is not responsible for any lost or stolen property.
- 11. Fires are not allowed on any portion of the property or the beach.
- 12. No smoking allowed in common areas, corridors, hallways, balconies, pool areas, hot tub areas nor inside buildings. Smoking in designated areas only.
- 13. Quiet hours are from 10 PM to 7 AM. Please be considerate of others and refrain from loud music, loud noises or running through the hallways.
- 14. Areas outside the units are common areas & are managed & governed by the Association. No items are allowed to be hung or displayed without Association approval.
- 15. Return luggage and utility carts to the designated areas after using and never take luggage and/or grocery carts inside the condo, to the pool, hot tubs, or beach.
- 16. DO NOT place garbage or trash outside the dumpster.
- 17. Exercise rooms, saunas and steam room age requirement for use is 16 years or older.
- 18. Beach wheelchairs may not be stored in the hallways or stairwells of the buildings. Please contact security to find out the appropriate storage area @ (251) 201-6010.
- 19. No tents are allowed in front of the rental lounges on the beach.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Pool & Hot Tubs

- 1. Pools & hot tub hours are 7 AM-10 PM; this rule is strictly enforced.
- 2. Horseplay is not allowed in or around the pool area.
- 3. Glassware is not allowed in the gated areas of the pools or hot tubs.
- 4. Diving is not allowed in the pool or hot tubs
- 5. Music at the pools requires headphones or earbuds to be worn. Music must not be played loud.
- 6. No one under the age of 12 is allowed in hot tubs.
- 7. Children 12 or under must be accompanied by an adult in the pool area.
- 8. There are no lifeguards on duty at the pools or beach. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK!
- 9. No babies or non-toilet trained children are allowed in pools unless they are wearing "Pullups", "Swimmers", swim diapers or similar protection against contaminating the pool. Feces in a pool will cause the pool to be closed to ALL for up to 24 hours for clean-up (per Baldwin County Health Department Regulations) AND parents may be charged the cost of the cleanup.
- 10. Security has the authority to enforce all rules.

Parking Lot

- 1. Registration certification must appear in plain sight on the dash of the car or car will be towed at the owner's expense.
- 2. Only park in designated areas. The Association is not responsible for any damage that occurs to your vehicle while parked on the property.

Violation of Property Rules/Regulations

- 1. First a written warning will be issued to owners/guests violating a property rule or regulation.
- 2. The second violation by a guest could result in eviction, depending on the violation. Security has the authority to remove guests from the property at their discretion. This can occur at the time of the first violation or any time after.

Laundry



Laundry machines have the ability to pay via quarters, credit card or app (each machine has a different number and QR code) through the system installed on the second floor of Buildings 1, 2 and 3 and in Building 4 East and Building 4 West laundry rooms. Each machine is \$2.50.

BOSS

- How to use the laundry via The Laundry BOSS app:
- -Download "The Laundry BOSS" app on your device
- -Sign up on app and add credit card
- -Scan appropriate washing machine or dryer QR code
- -Add to basket
- -Check out
- -Buttons on machine you chose will light up for you to select your preferences on machine

Benefit of the app is that you do not have to stand at the kiosk to complete transaction and can use your device versus carrying coins or credit card to laundry. You can also see time left on your dryer machine in the app.

• How to use the laundry via credit card at kiosk:

- -Press Start a Machine (left side of screen)
- -Enter the machine number (on top of machine you want to use) and press next on that and next screen
- -Select start another machine or check out
- -Select Proceed to Pay

-Select Pay with Credit Card (there is also an option as shown in #6 below to Pay with Loyalty Points or Digital Wallet from login information from app here as well)

-Swipe card once and wait for beep and authorization

HOW TO SPOT A RIP CURRENT

- Rip currents are most prevalent when the waves crash perpendicular to the beach rather than at an angle.
- One of the easiest ways to spot a rip current is to look for gaps between the waves. A small patch of calm water surrounded by waves is often a rip current.
- Look for discolored water near the shore. Rip currents tend to drag large amounts of sand and sediment back out to sea with them, so many rip currents are easily identified by a noticeable flow of sand extending away from the shore.
- Rip currents are also common in areas near sand bars, piers, pilings and jetties.

HOW TO ESCAPE A RIP CURRENT

- Remain calm. Fighting the rip current can exhaust you.
- Escape the current by swimming parallel to the shoreline. When free of the current, swim at an angle—away from the current—toward shore.
- If unable to escape by swimming, float, or tread water. When the current weakens, swim at an angle away from the current toward the shore.
- If at any time you feel you will be unable to reach shore, draw attention to yourself: face the shore, call, or wave for help.
- To help someone else caught in a rip current, first call 9-1-1 for assistance, then seek help from a lifeguard. If a lifeguard is not present, yell instructions on how to escape or throw the victim something that floats.

Swimming in the Gulf is much different than swimming in a pool. It is important to respect the strength of the sea and the marine life that lives there.

- ALWAYS check surf and weather conditions before heading to the beach and observe beach flags.
- Never swim alone. Always stay in groups. Don't wander too far from shore.
- Don't swim near piers, pilings, and platforms. Exercise caution when swimming in areas between sandbars or near steep drop-offs.
- Do not swim in areas being used by fishermen. Avoid swimming in areas where schools of fish are present. Diving seabirds are good indicators of areas to avoid.
- Alcohol and swimming do not mix.
- Use extra caution when water is murky. Avoid being in the water during dusk, nighttime, or twilight hours.
- Avoid wearing shiny jewelry and clothing.
- Stay informed of local weather and beach conditions.

1. Get Out of the Water

- 2. Stop the Stinging
- Rinse the area with vinegar for at least 30 seconds.
- Remove tentacles with a pair of tweezers.
- After you remove the tentacles, soak the affected area in hot water (104-113 F or 40-45 C) for at least 20 minutes. If you don't have a thermometer, make sure the water is hot but not scalding. A hot shower is OK if that's easier than soaking. Stay in the water for 20 to 45 minutes.
- These treatments are based on research done in the Indo-Pacific areas and may not work for all stings.
- 3. Treat Discomfort
- Use mild <u>hydrocortisone</u> cream or an oral <u>antihistamine</u> to relieve <u>itching</u> and swelling.

4. Follow Up

For less severe stings:

- Use ice packs or over-the-counter pain relievers or antihistamines for welts.
- Clean open sores three times a day and apply antibiotic ointment. Bandage if needed.

Call 911 if:

- The person displays signs of a severe allergic reaction
- The sting is from a box jellyfish.
- The sting covers more than half an arm or leg.

SEA TURTLE NESTING SEASON

Please remember that May 1-October 31st is Sea Turtle Nesting Season.

Sea turtles live in a variety of habitats, and these can change over time for many reasons including their life cycle stage, weather, and human interaction. Their diverse habitats include:

- Beaches: female sea turtles lay eggs in nests on sandy beaches. After incubating for about 2 months, the eggs hatch and baby turtles make their way to the ocean
- Open ocean: juveniles grow up in rafts of sargassum seaweed which provide food
- Coastal waters: loggerheads, Kemp's ridleys, and green sea turtles feed in estuaries and other shallow coastal waters
- Reefs: loggerheads rely on deep offshore reefs for food

Three species of sea turtles nest on Alabama's Gulf Coast: Loggerhead, Kemp's Ridley, and Green sea turtles. Our most common nesting sea turtle here in Gulf Shores is the Loggerhead. At night, female Loggerheads will emerge from the Gulf to lay about 120 eggs in their nest and then return to the water. Baby sea turtles grow inside these eggs, and once they are all ready, they hatch and crawl out of their nest together. Just like their mama, Loggerhead turtles prefer nighttime, so they leave their nest, follow the light reflecting off the water from the moon, and crawl towards the Gulf in the dark. It is important we help protect these sea turtles by doing the following:

Avoid using flashlights or flash photography on the beach at night. If you do use a light at night, please use red filter lights.

Turn off outside patio lights and shield indoor lights from shining onto the beach at night.

Do not disturb sea turtle nests.

Keep your distance (at least 30 feet) from adult turtles that come onto the beach to nest.
